### **Psalms 115:12–18 (NKJV)**

12 The Lord has been mindful of us; He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. 13 He will bless those who fear the Lord, both small and great. 14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children. 15 May you be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth. 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; but the earth He has given to the children of men. 17 The dead do not praise the Lord, nor any who go down into silence. 18 But we will bless the Lord from this time forth and forevermore. Praise the Lord!

### **James 1:12–17 (NKJV)**

12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. 14 But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death. 16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren. 17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

### **James 4:5–10 (NKJV)**

5 Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"? 6 But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." 7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. 10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

### **James 5:13–18 (NKJV)**

13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. 14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. 16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. 17 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. 18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.

---

### **Hebrews 13:1–6 (NKJV)**

1 Let brotherly love continue. 2 Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels. 3 Remember the prisoners as if chained with them—those who are mistreated—since you yourselves are in the body also. 4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge. 5 Let your conduct be without

covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." 6 So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

---

### **Hebrews 13:14–17 (NKJV)**

14 For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come. 15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. 16 But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. 17 Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

---

### **Revelation 2:1–5 (NKJV)**

1 "To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: 2 I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; 3 and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. 4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. 5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent.'"

---

### **Revelation 2:8–11 (NKJV)**

8 "And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write, 'These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life: 9 I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. 10 Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life. 11 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.'"

---

### **Isaiah 52:13–15 (NKJV)**

13 Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; he shall be exalted and extolled and be very high. 14 Just as many were astonished at you, so His visage was marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men; 15 So shall He sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall see, and what they had not heard they shall consider.

---

### **Isaiah 53:1–3 (NKJV)**

1 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? 2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; and when we see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. 3 He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

---

**Isaiah 53:4–6 (NKJV)**

4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

---

**Isaiah 53:7–9 (NKJV)**

7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of My people He was stricken. 9 And they made His grave with the wicked— but with the rich at His death, because He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth.

---

**Isaiah 53:10–12 (NKJV)**

10 Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

---

**Psalms 16:1–6 (NKJV)**

1 Preserve me, O God, for in You I put my trust. 2 O my soul, you have said to the Lord, “You are my Lord, my goodness is nothing apart from You.” 3 As for the saints who are on the earth, “They are the excellent ones, in whom is all my delight.” 4 Their sorrows shall be multiplied who hasten after another god; their drink offerings of blood I will not offer, nor take up their names on my lips. 5 O Lord, You are the portion of my inheritance and my cup; You maintain my lot. 6 The lines have fallen to me in pleasant places; yes, I have a good inheritance.

---

**Psalms 16:7–11 (NKJV)**

7 I will bless the Lord who has given me counsel; my heart also instructs me in the night seasons. 8 I have set the Lord always before me; because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved. 9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; my flesh also will rest in hope. 10 For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. 11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

---

**Key Verse: Galatians 5:22–23 (NKJV)**

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

---

**Love of the Lord****1 John 4:8 (NKJV)**

He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

**John 3:16 (NKJV)**

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**Romans 5:5 (NKJV)**

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

**Romans 5:8 (NKJV)**

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**Ephesians 2:4–5 (NKJV)**

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).

---

**Joy of the Lord****John 16:24**

Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

**Psalms 4:7**

You have put gladness in my heart, more than in the season that their grain and wine increased.

**Psalms 19:8**

The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

**Luke 15:7**

I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

**Psalms 113:9**

He gives the barren woman a home, like a joyful mother of children. Praise the Lord!

---

**Peace of the Lord****Psalms 29:11**

The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

**Isaiah 9:6**

For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

**John 14:27**

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

**Jeremiah 29:11**

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

**Isaiah 32:18**

My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, In secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places.

---

**Patience of the Lord****2 Peter 3:9**

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

**Joel 2:13**

And rend your heart, and not your garments; return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm.

**1 Thessalonians 3:5**

For this reason, when I could no longer endure it, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter had tempted you, and our labor might be in vain.

**Isaiah 30:18**

Therefore the Lord will wait, that He may be gracious to you; and therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for Him.

**Deuteronomy 7:9**

Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments.

---

**Kindness of the Lord****Psalms 145:9**

The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works.

**Psalms 18:25–26**

With the merciful You will show Yourself merciful; with a blameless man You will show Yourself blameless; with the pure You will show Yourself pure; and with the devious You will show Yourself shrewd. For You will save the humble people, but will bring down haughty looks.

**Romans 11:22**

Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.

**Exodus 11:3**

Now the Lord had made the people favorably disposed toward Moses.

## **Goodness of the Lord**

### **Jeremiah 31:14**

I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the Lord.

### **Psalms 31:19**

Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, which You have prepared for those who trust in You, in the presence of the sons of men!

### **Psalms 65:11**

You crown the year with Your goodness, and Your paths drip with abundance.

### **Psalms 107:8–9**

Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness.

### **Romans 8:28**

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

## **Faith**

### **Hebrews 12:1–3**

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.

---

## **Temperance of the Lord**

### **Matthew 4:3–11 (NKJV)**

3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." 4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'" 5 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, 6 and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge concerning You,' and, 'In their hands they shall bear You up, Lest You dash Your foot against a stone.'" 7 Jesus said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the Lord your God.'" 8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. 9 And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'" 11 Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

---

## **Walking in Love**

### **Matthew 22:37–40 (NKJV)**

Jesus said to him, “ ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”

### **Ephesians 5:25–28 (NKJV)**

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself.

## **Walking in Joy**

### **Philippians 4:4 (NKJV)**

Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!

### **Romans 12:15 (NKJV)**

Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

### **Ecclesiastes 11:9 (NKJV)**

Rejoice, O young man, in your youth, and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth; walk in the ways of your heart, and in the sight of your eyes; but know that for all these God will bring you into judgment.

### **Psalms 122:1 (NKJV)**

I was glad when they said to me, “Let us go into the house of the Lord.”

### **2 Corinthians 9:7 (NKJV)**

So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

---

## **Walking in Peace**

### **Hebrews 12:14 (NKJV)**

Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord.

### **Psalms 119:165 (NKJV)**

Great peace have those who love Your law, and nothing causes them to stumble.

### **Romans 2:10 (NKJV)**

But glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

### **Proverbs 16:7 (NKJV)**

When a man's ways please the Lord, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

**Matthew 5:9 (NKJV)**

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

**Psalms 37:37 (NKJV)**

Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; for the future of that man is peace.

---

**Walking in Patience****Romans 12:12 (NKJV)**

Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.

**Romans 5:3–4 (NKJV)**

And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope.

**James 1:3 (NKJV)**

Knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

**Hebrews 6:11–12 (NKJV)**

And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

---

**Walking in Gentleness****Zechariah 7:9–10 (NKJV)**

“Thus says the Lord of hosts: ‘Execute true justice, show mercy and compassion everyone to his brother. Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless, the alien or the poor. Let none of you plan evil in his heart against his brother.’ ”

---

**Walking in Goodness****Ephesians 5:9 (NKJV)**

For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness and truth.

**Ruth 3:10 (NKJV)**

Then he said, “Blessed are you of the Lord, my daughter! For you have shown more kindness at the end than at the beginning, in that you did not go after young men, whether poor or rich.”

**Acts 17:11 (NKJV)**

These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.

---

**Walking in Faith****Mark 16:16 (NKJV)**

He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

**Acts 6:8 (NKJV)**

And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.

**Romans 14:1 (NKJV)**

Receive one who is weak in the faith, but not to disputes over doubtful things.

**1 Corinthians 16:13 (NKJV)**

Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong.

---

**Walking in Meekness****Matthew 5:5 (NKJV)**

Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

**Galatians 6:1 (NKJV)**

Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

**Philippians 4:5 (NKJV)**

Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand.

**1 Thessalonians 5:14 (NKJV)**

Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all.

---

**Walking in Temperance****Matthew 5:28 (NKJV)**

But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

**1 Corinthians 9:25 (NKJV)**

And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown.

**Galatians 5:24 (NKJV)**

And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

**1 John 2:16 (NKJV)**

For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

---

**The Five-Fold Ministry****Ephesians 4:11–13 (NKJV)**

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

---

## **Apostles**

### **Luke 6:13 (NKJV)**

And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles.

### **Acts 2:43 (NKJV)**

Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles.

### **Acts 4:33 (NKJV)**

And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.

### **Hebrews 3:1 (NKJV)**

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus.

### **Revelation 21:14 (NKJV)**

Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

---

## **Prophets – Part 1**

### **Numbers 12:6 (NKJV)**

Then He said, “Hear now My words: if there is a prophet among you, I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream.”

### **Deuteronomy 13:1–3 (NKJV)**

“If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, ‘Let us go after other gods’—which you have not known—‘and let us serve them,’ you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the Lord your God is testing you to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.”

### **Deuteronomy 18:22 (NKJV)**

When a prophet speaks in the name of the Lord, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the Lord has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.

---

## **Prophets – Part 2**

### **Matthew 10:41 (NKJV)**

He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet’s reward. And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man’s reward.

### **Amos 3:7 (NKJV)**

Surely the Lord God does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

## **2 Peter 1:21 (NKJV)**

For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

## **1 Corinthians 14:32 (NKJV)**

And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

---

## **False Prophets – Part 3**

### **Matthew 7:15 (NKJV)**

Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

### **Matthew 24:24 (NKJV)**

For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

### **1 John 4:1 (NKJV)**

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

---

## **Evangelists – Part 1**

### **Isaiah 52:7 (NKJV)**

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace, who brings glad tidings of good things, who proclaims salvation, who says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

### **Mark 16:15–16 (NKJV)**

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned."

### **Acts 8:4 (NKJV)**

Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word.

### **Matthew 24:14 (NKJV)**

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

---

## **Evangelists – Part 2**

### **Isaiah 61:1–3 (NKJV)**

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."

---

### **Evangelists – Part 3**

#### **Acts 13:33 (NKJV)**

God has fulfilled this for us their children, in that He has raised up Jesus. As it is also written in the second Psalm: “You are My Son, today I have begotten You.”

#### **Mark 10:29–30 (NKJV)**

So Jesus answered and said, “Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel’s, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions—and in the age to come, eternal life.”

---

### **Evangelists – Part 4**

#### **Acts 20:22-24 (NKJV)**

And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. but none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

---

### **Evangelists – Part 5**

#### **Romans 1:16 (NKJV)**

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

#### **Romans 15:21 (NKJV)**

But as it is written: “To whom He was not announced, they shall see; and those who have not heard shall understand.”

#### **1 Corinthians 9:16 (NKJV)**

For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel!

---

### **Evangelists – Part 6**

#### **1 Thessalonians 2:4 (NKJV)**

But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.
